Q. What is the difference between full overlay cabinets and partial overlay cabinets?

A full overlay cabinet has less of the frame exposed from a showing usually about 1/8-1/4". A partial overlay cabinet has more exposed frame showing, usually be-tween 1/2"-5/8". One or the other is not better, it is a matter of personal preference. Usually, full overlay cabinets are a bit more expensive.


